CANSI Ontario Finance Director Report for 2017-2018

Please refer to the Profit and Loss, and Balance Sheet summary reports below when reviewing this financial report. The P&L report includes the previous year for comparison.

CANSI Ontario shows a net income loss of approximately \$4,728 for the year ending April 30, 2018. A number of courses were successfully run in Ontario, more than doubling the gross income from last year.

The XC courses brought in \$893, while the Telemark courses lost \$3,416, resulting in the net loss of \$2,523 on courses alone. This is discussed in more detail in the Telemark and XC Reports. CANSI National and Technical Committee are in favour of offsetting some of the loss from the Level II course, amount to be determined soon.

CANSI Ontario paid out the second half of Justin's scholarship (\$160) in April 2018.

XC chose to sponsor Wendy Grator to attend CANSI XC IV in BC in the amount of \$1,081.47 in the interest of obtaining her level IV and becoming a high-level Ontario course conductor.

Last year, National contributed an additional \$272 to the Refresher subsidy to cover Telemark's losses. The AGM and instructor awards for 2017 totaled \$885.

The only other expenses incurred were bank fees. Thank you to Jan for negotiating with Scotiabank to reduce our fees from \$9.95 / month to \$2.50 / month. The OSC account does not incur any fees, it does gain a small amount of interest totaling \$2.47 last year.

Over the past 10 years, CANSI Ontario has frequently operated at a significant deficit. Some years, this has been compensated for by course conductor donations and subsidies from National. However, it is not a sustainable operating model and requires the attention of the Board of Directors to address.
